- Data demonstrating effectiveness (if available).

Presentation proposals must contain the following information:

- Institution
- Contact Information: Email, Telephone, Mailing Address
- Title of Session
- Type of Session (Presentation, Hands-on workshop, Panel, etc)
- Length of Session
- Session Abstract (200 word limit)
- Expected Session Outcomes (How will this topic help business educators do a better job in helping students learn, or helping faculty better assess and provide feedback on student learning, or helping programs be more successful in seeking accreditation, or better prepare students for the world of business?)
