Candidate will coordinate the accounting degree(s) and play an important role in expanding the undergraduate accounting program with a focus on C.P.A. preparation as well as helping to develop possible M.B.A. and/or M.S. Accountancy programs.

Qualifications: Ph.D. or D.B.A. in Accounting preferred. A.B.D.'s with imminent completion date, M.B.A./C.P.A.'s and J.D./C.P.A.'s will be considered. Rank is dependent upon qualifications and experience. Faculty members are expected to maintain academic qualifications consistent with accreditation standards for scholarship and intellectual contributions as well as fulfilling service obligations including college and school governance, academic advisement, professional development and other needed activities.
