



IACBE Members Form Summer MBA Sustainability Consortium



The Summer MBA Sustainability Consortium is a cooperative endeavor through which member institutions may offer summer MBA courses related to sustainable business, and MBA students from any consortium member may take the courses for transfer credit.

The two most active participants in the Consortium are IACBE members Maharishi University of Management and Marylhurst University, each of which is contributing courses to the program.

The Consortium was founded in 2012 by eight universities – Bainbridge Graduate Institute, Brandeis University, Maharishi University of Management, Marylhurst University, Seattle Pacific University, University of Denver, University of Maine, and the University of Vermont. Antioch University New England and the University of Wisconsin at Whitewater joined the Consortium in 2013.
