The IACBE Board of Commissioners met July 17, 2019 to consider your request for the accreditation of the business programs offered by the College of Business and Management at Lynn University. I am pleased to report that the Board of Commissioners approved your request and granted accreditation to your business programs accompanied by the following note.

Principle 1.1: Outcomes Assessment

1. Review and revise the intended student learning outcomes (ISLOs) to differentiate between the undergraduate and graduate degree programs.
2. Currently the assessment tools used in the undergraduate and graduate level programs are the same. The only difference is the scoring on the tool. Graduate level course material is different from undergraduate material, not only in difficulty and depth but also in content. Ensure that assessment tools reflect this difference.
3. Remove evaluation language such as “corresponds to a C” when referring to assessment items.

Accreditation represents a continuing relationship between an institution and its accrediting organization. Specialized program accreditation by the IACBE is dependent upon your institution remaining (i) in good standing with your institutional accrediting body and (ii) in compliance with the IACBE’s Accreditation Principles and Policies. Your accreditation is valid for seven years, through December 31, 2026. In addition to the compliance reports due November 1 of each year, all accredited members of the IACBE are required to submit an Interim Quality Assurance Report (IQAR) during their period of accreditation.
