Dear Dr. Gulmez:

At its July 2022 meeting, the IACBE Board of Commissioners considered your request for the accreditation of the business programs offered by the Faculty of Economics and Administrative Sciences at CAG University. I am pleased to report that the Board of Commissioners approved your request and granted first-time specialized accreditation to the business program(s) as identified in the "Business Programs" table below, accompanied by the following note(s) and observation(s).

Notes

Notes are an indicator that while the program is in compliance with the Principles, additional monitoring is warranted. The Faculty of Economics and Administrative Sciences is required to take action as specified below and respond to the IACBE by October 16, 2022 (unless another due date is indicated within the Note) using the IACBE Notes Report. Principle 2.1: Outcomes Assessment

1. Ensure that all rubric categories explicitly align with the ISLO the category is intended to measure. An example of this is: In the Final Presentation Evaluation Rubric, category 4 is "Formatting/Use of references" and the selection possibilities are all related to APA formatting and use of language. The rubric indicates that this category is used to measure ISLO 4, "Students will be able to carry out the ethical and legal principles when making decisions in global business environments".

Observations

Observations are suggestions for further quality enhancements that the Board of Commissioners believes would be helpful for you in achieving excellence in business education but are not required for compliance with the IACBE's Accreditation Principles. Action on observations is optional, and reporting is not required.

Specialized program accreditation by the IACBE is dependent upon your institution remaining (i) in good standing with your institutional accrediting body and (ii) in compliance with the IACBE’s Accreditation Principles and Policies.

Your Approved Period of Accreditation is: July 19, 2022 – July 31, 2029

All programs receiving IACBE accreditation for the first-time must come into compliance with the requirement for public disclosure of student achievement, and the prescribed statement of accreditation within 30 days of the date of this letter. In addition to these annual compliance reports, all accredited members of the IACBE are required to submit an Interim Quality Assurance Report (IQAR) during their period of accreditation. The IQAR for the Faculty of Economics and Administrative Sciences will be due by November 1, 2025.
