At its December 2022 meeting, the IACBE Board of Commissioners considered your request for the accreditation of the business programs offered by the IFM Business School. I am pleased to report that the Board of Commissioners approved your request and granted specialized accreditation to the business program(s) as identified in the "Business Programs" table below, accompanied by the following note(s) and observation(s).

## <u>Notes</u>

Notes are an indicator that while the program is in compliance with the Principles, additional monitoring is warranted. The IFM Business School is required to take action as specified below and respond to the IACBE by March 8, 2023 (unless another due date is indicated within the Note). ## Principle 2.1: Outcomes Assessment

- 1. Provide a copy of the direct assessment measure for MBA MA5 (Lead effectively a team of colleagues on diverse projects).
- For Intended Student Learning Outcome (ISLO) #6, the Master's Expression Quantitative Assessment Survey (completed by faculty) was incorrectly categorized as an indirect measure. Because ISLO #6 is already assessed twice by other assessment measures, the institution may opt to:
  - a. Relist this tool as a direct measure in future reporting or
  - b. Remove this tool as a measure for ISLOs in future reporting (you can continue to use it internally but would not need to report on it given that ISLO 6 has a direct and an indirect assessment measure and is adequately covered currently).
