Please remove CapSim's Peer Review as a direct measure of ISLO2. Peer review by itself should not be used as direct measure for teamwork. Peer review in addition to the instructor's assessment of teamwork can be used. Since you already have a measure of teamwork, you can choose to modify or eliminate the peer review.

Observations

Observations are suggestions for further quality enhancements that the Board of Commissioners believes would be helpful for you in achieving excellence in business education but are not required for compliance with the IACBE's Accreditation Principles. Action on observations is optional, and reporting is not required.

Principle 2.1: Outcomes Assessment

The commissioners suggest you may want to review ISLO #2 in order to more explicitly include leadership.
