Dear Dr. Loughran:

At its July 2024 meeting, the IACBE Board of Commissioners considered your request to extend the Candidacy period for Siena Heights University. I am pleased to report that the Board of Commissioners approved your request.

The Candidacy period is to afford the academic business unit with an opportunity to prepare itself to be in compliance with the IACBE's Accreditation Principles, to develop a comprehensive self-study, and to undergo a site visit. Maintaining Candidacy status with the IACBE is dependent upon your institution remaining (i) in good standing with your institutional accrediting body and (ii) in compliance with the IACBE's policies.

## Your Extended Approved Period of Candidacy is: March 30, 2020 – April 30, 2026

Based on this approval, to be considered at the April 2026 Board of Commissioners meaning your Candidacy site visit will need to occur **no later than January 15, 2026.** Please contact your liaison as soon as possible to schedule the site visit.

## Additionally:

Work with your liaison to determine the due date for the Draft Candidacy Application Part II
45 days prior to the start of the site visit – Final Candidacy Application Part II
You, or someone at the business unit who will be involved in the self-study process, are required to
attend an Accreditation Institute no later than April 2025.

You are required to maintain compliance with all IACBE reporting requirements and notifications. For more information on these reports, please refer to the IACBE website under Accreditation > Compliance.
