How to get to Gdansk

Gdansk Lech Walesa Airport located around 15 km away from the city center, handles domestic and international flights.

From the airport to the city center there are many public transport connections.

The passengers may get to the city center from Gdansk Lech Walesa Airport by SKM (Szybka Kolej Miejska) trains or by bus 210 to Gdansk Glowny.

By train

Students Case Competition

Competitions offer a chance for participants to gain substantial experience, showcase skills, analyze and evaluate outcomes and uncover personal attitude. Competitions also encourage students to adopt innovative techniques and develop their ideas and skills.

Schools are invited to bring up to three teams of students to compete in the student case study competition. A team of students must include two, three or four students.

On the first day of the conference, the teams will be handed a case study to prepare.

Students will be given 3 hours to prepare their case presentation. Each team will then give a 20-minute presentation, which will be judged by a panel of three experts. Prizes will be awarded for the first place, second place, and third place teams. Recognition of the teams will be held at the beginning of the dinner at the end of
