## 30. Process for Adding New Location or a New Partner

The commissioners noted that IACBE accredits programs, not sites. Staff was directed to simplify the list of approved programs for schools to list the approved programs and followed by "these programs are accredited at any of the following sites" rather than listing all of the sites next to each approved program.

### 31. School Located in "Dangerous" Areas

Discussion was held regarding the importance to our mission in helping to establish schools in areas of great need. The commissioners recommended that "virtual" visits may be appropriate to grant "interim" or similar accreditation if (1) site team members can be physically together at a safe location with a representative from the school (e.g. in an adjoining country); (2) the site team members can connect virtually to the actual site with representatives at the site and; (3) all other international rules still apply.

The commissioners agreed that staff should notify the school in Afghanistan that a plan will be devised at the July meeting to pilot such a visit for their programs.
