- A Short Description of the Presentation (75-150 words)
- Any Special Audio-visual needs. (Internet access may not be available in the presentation room, so all resources needed for presentations should be available on your flash drives.)
- * Time slot preference Thursday morning or afternoon, Friday morning. (not guaranteed)
