

Proposal Submission Guidelines:

All proposals for conference presentations must include the following elements:

- The name(s) and affiliation(s) of presenters
- Title of the presentation
- A 150 word abstract of the presentation
- Fully developed summary of the presentation (3 to 5 pages)
- Audio-visual technology needs
- Presentations designed for 30 minutes, including time for questions and answers.
- Submission deadline: September 30th, 2023
- Rolling acceptances given no later than October 6th, 2023
