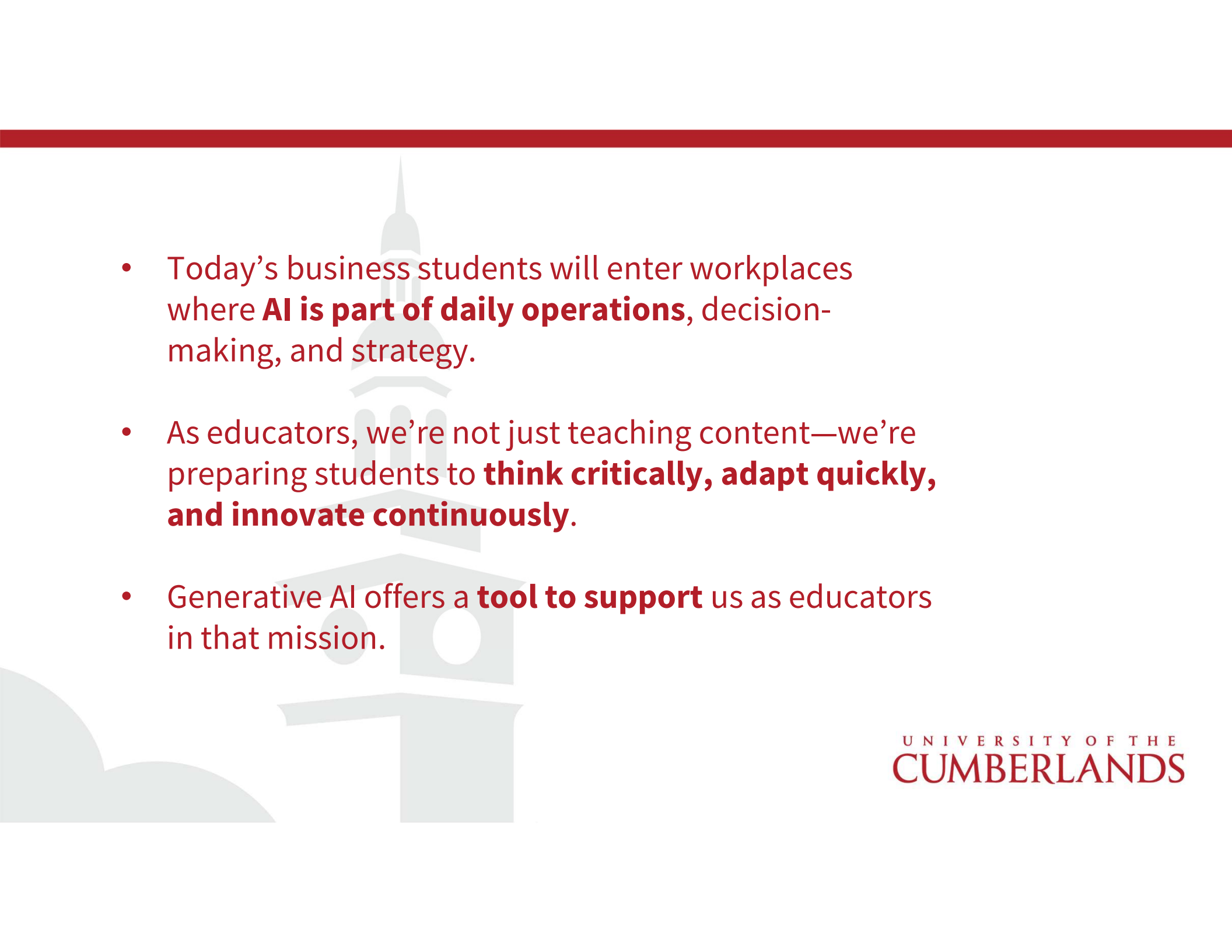

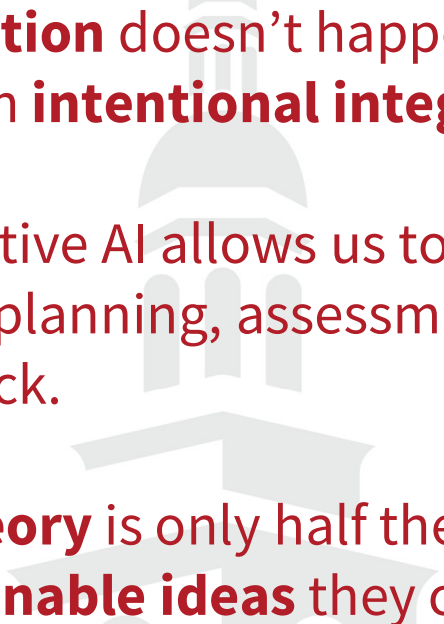

## **COURSE DEVELOPMENT**

**1**

**“I’m designing a business course for undergraduate students. The course is [course name]. Can you help outline the key learning objectives and suggest relevant topics or modules to include in the syllabus?”**

## LESSON PLANNING

2

**"Create a 50-minute lesson plan for a college-level course in [insert topic, e.g., Principles of Marketing], including objectives, key discussion questions, a brief activity, and assessment ideas."**



## LECTURE SLIDES

3

**"Generate a slide-by-slide outline for a lecture on [insert topic, e.g., consumer behavior], with bullet points, examples, and suggested visuals or media."**

## INSTRUCTIONAL STRATEGIES

**“Suggest three interactive activities or simulations to teach [specific concept, e.g., negotiation skills or sustainability] in a way that engages students and encourages collaboration.”**

## REAL-WORLD CONNECTION

**"Suggest 3 real-world company examples or current events that illustrate the concept of [insert topic, e.g., competitive advantage] and briefly explain how they relate."**

## LEARNING STYLES

**“Create three examples of how [specific topic, e.g., business ethics] could be adapted for different learning styles (visual, auditory, and kinesthetic learners).”**

## DISCUSSION PROMPT

7

**"Write a thought-provoking discussion prompt for students in an undergraduate business course about [insert topic], including a current event tie-in and follow-up questions."**

## OBJECT LESSON

8

**"Create an object lesson to help college business students understand the concept of [insert topic, e.g., opportunity cost, market segmentation, customer lifetime value]. Use a common household item or classroom prop to illustrate the concept in a memorable and interactive way. Include setup instructions, talking points, and a debrief question."**

## E-MAIL ASSISTANCE

**"Draft a professional and empathetic email response to a student who missed a deadline for a major assignment, offering options for moving forward."**

## END-OF-COURSE REFLECTION

10

**"Write a final reflection prompt for college business students that encourages them to connect course content to real-world application and future career goals. Make it open-ended and thought-provoking."**
